

CWC HIGH FIVE FOR SAFETY

STOP- If a coyote or a domestic dog approaches you. Do not move forward or turn around and run.



STAND STILL- *Remain calm and do not scream.*



SHOUT and **WAVE** arms above the head. Shouting '*coyote go away*' can scare away the coyote and alerts others around that a coyote is in the vicinity. Use a firm and loud voice. Never scream. Throw an object in the direction of the coyote.



SLOWLY BACK AWAY – Shout '*coyote go away*'. Never turn your back or run from a coyote or domestic dog. Running may initiate the chase or play instinct.



SHARE THE EXPERIENCE. Encourage thoughtful dialogue about wildlife encounters. This will help to get a better look at what happened and learn from the experience.
